

SCOTTISH programme at Inti gets a boost

INTI College has strengthened ties with two universities in Scotland — University of Dundee and University of Aberdeen.

These, together with its existing twinning arrangements with Heriot-Watt University, make up Inti's Scottish Universities Programme which offer degree courses in Accountancy and Business.

The vice-chancellor of Dundee, Dr Ian J Graham-Bryce, was recently at Inti and met with college president Tan Yew Sing.

Dundee's Bachelor of Accountancy degree enables exemption for up to eight papers for the ACCA. This is among the highest exemptions awarded for ACCA by universities in Britain.

Aberdeen also offers an equal number of exemptions for its Accounting degree graduates. Students granted the exemptions can forego the Foundation and Certificate stages of the ACCA examination and start immediately at the professional stage. This means that students need only sit for six papers out of a total of 14.
