

British degree at Inti

IN supporting the Government's call to provide an alternative for students to do their studies locally, Inti College is offering a British degree programme here.

This was made possible after Inti College's agreement with the Coventry University in Britain last month.

Through the agreement, Inti College will offer an honours degree in Computing and Information Technology (IT). All students who complete the Inti Graduate Diploma in Computing and IT (which will be offered in the April 1998 semester) will be awarded a graduate diploma by the college and an honours degree by the university.

Inti College president Tan Yew Sing and Professor Robert Pryce, vice-chancellor of Coventry University, signed the agreement, witnessed by Inti College board of governors chairman Tan Sri Dr. Abdul Majid Ismail at the college on Feb 26.

The arrangement will enable Inti students to complete the university's three-year BSc (Hons) in Computing and Information Technology at the college. Students can major either in Computer Sciences or Business Information Technology. They are required to com-

plete two semesters at Inti College, which is equivalent to the third year of study at Coventry University.

The status of the students at Inti College is equivalent academically to that of the students at the university.

To be admitted into the graduate diploma programmes, students must have successfully completed the Inti Higher Diploma in Computer Science or Business Information Technology or possess an equivalent qualification from other recognised institutions of higher learning.

Inti College has signed a similar agreement with the University of Hertfordshire, in Britain. The agreement will enable Inti students to obtain a Bachelor in Business Administration (Hons) locally under the college's Graduate Diploma programme.
