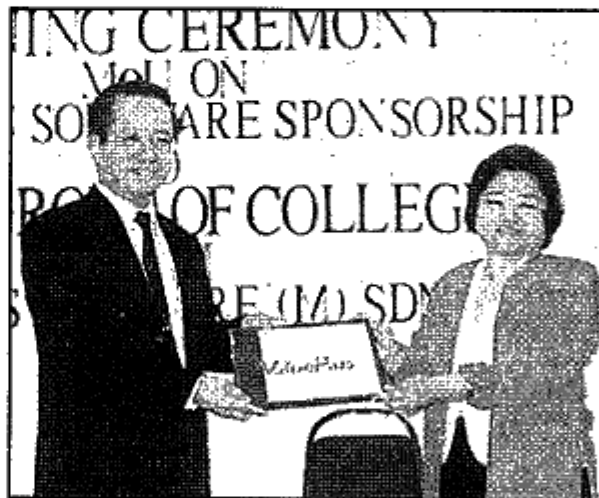
Both the packages will be incorporated into the curriculum of the accounting and business courses offered by the School of Business and Law.
