INTI College recently signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the University of Wollongong to offer the Master of Quality Management programme.

Vice-president of administration Dr Lee Fah Onn signed the MoU on behalf of the college, while the university was represented by its Business School director Prof John J Glynn.

Present to witness the event was Institut Aminuddin Baki director Dr Ibrahim Ahmad Bajunid.

The programme offers studies in modern management and productivity improvement concepts and techniques.

The course, conducted on a part-time basis, can be com-

pleted in 16 months.

In his speech, Dr Lee said that Inti was proud to associate itself with Wollongong, one of the top 10 universities in Australia.

He added that the university would provide instructional staff to the college, while Inti lecturers and practitioners from local industries would offer a Malaysian per-

spective to the course.

The first intake for the programme is expected to begin next year after approval is gained from the Education Ministry.

This is the second master's programme to be offered by Inti, after the Master of Business Administration in collaboration with the University of Missouri, Kansas City.
