THE University of Wollongong was first established in 1951, and is located 80km from Sydney.

Currently, its student population stands at 13,000, with 2,000 overseas students, out of which 178 are from Malaysia.

The university is independently ranked in the Top 10 of Australia's national universities, and combines traditional academic values with innovative teaching and advanced technology.

The University provides a complete package of education on a single campus, from English language, vocational diploma and undergraduate bridging courses to Bachelor Degrees, Graduate Diploma, Masters and PhD in nine faculties of Arts, Commerce, Creative Arts, Education, Engineering, Health and Behavioral Sciences, Informatics, Law and Science.

Courses offered are:

1. Vocational Courses with Ad-

vanced Standing - VETAB, accredited courses in Business (Marketing/Management), Hospitality, Tourism and Travel, and Information Technology can be completed to Advanced Diploma level in one year, with advanced standing into the Bachelor of Commerce.

2. Foundation Studies Courses - Preparation streams in Arts, Commerce, Computing and Science enable entry to bachelor courses in 9 months for those finishing SPM/ "O" levels.

3. Advanced Standing To Degree Courses - one to two years of

advanced standing is available to most courses at undergraduate level for graduates of Malaysian colleges.

4. The University of Wollongong also has credit transfer agreements in place with INTI, Kolej Aman, HELP and MARA, leading to bachelor courses in Commerce, Engineering, Informatics, Health and Behavioral Science, Arts, Creative Arts, Education, Law and Science.

Intakes for all courses begin in March, July and November.
