

Tie-ups boost for Scottish courses

BEING one of Inti College's oldest programmes, the Scottish University Degree Programme was given a boost recently with the establishment of formal links with the University of Dundee and the University of Aberdeen.

These two universities together with Heriot-Watt University make up Inti's twinning arrangements with Scottish universities offering degree courses in Accounting and Business Studies.

To ensure that high standards are maintained, Inti College works closely with its partner universities associated with the programme.

Every semester, examiners and representatives of these universities visit Inti College resulting in a close working relationship between the examiners and lecturers.

In the quality assessment report on the finance and accounting courses offered by the three universities, the examiners rated the University of Dundee as excellent while the University of Aberdeen and Heriot-Watt University were rated highly satisfactory.

The Scottish University Degree Programme is a three-year course of which two years are done at Inti College and the final year in UK.

The programme is not only cost effective but students at the same time obtain quality education through a programme structured to ensure academic standards, curriculum, syllabuses and examinations that correspond with those of the Scottish

universities.

The benefits derived from the programme are a qualification that is recognised worldwide and training of students to think independently resulting in more mature individuals who are capable of decision-making and problem solving.

Degrees offered are Accounting, Business Administration, Economics, Finance, Management Studies and Marketing.

Accounting majors can qualify as Chartered Management Accountants by obtaining three years business experience and passing the final four CIMA Professional Examination papers.

Other options include the Chartered Association of Certified Accountants (UK), or Institute of Chartered Accountants in England and Wales or Institute of Chartered Accountants of Scotland qualifications.

Students with three SPM credits plus two principal passes at STPM/'A' Levels with a total minimum of six points qualify for enrolment in the Scottish University Degree Programme.

Those without STPM/'A' Levels must undergo Inti's University Foundation Programme first.

Admission into the Scottish University Programme is guaranteed upon successful completion of the University Foundation Programme.
