

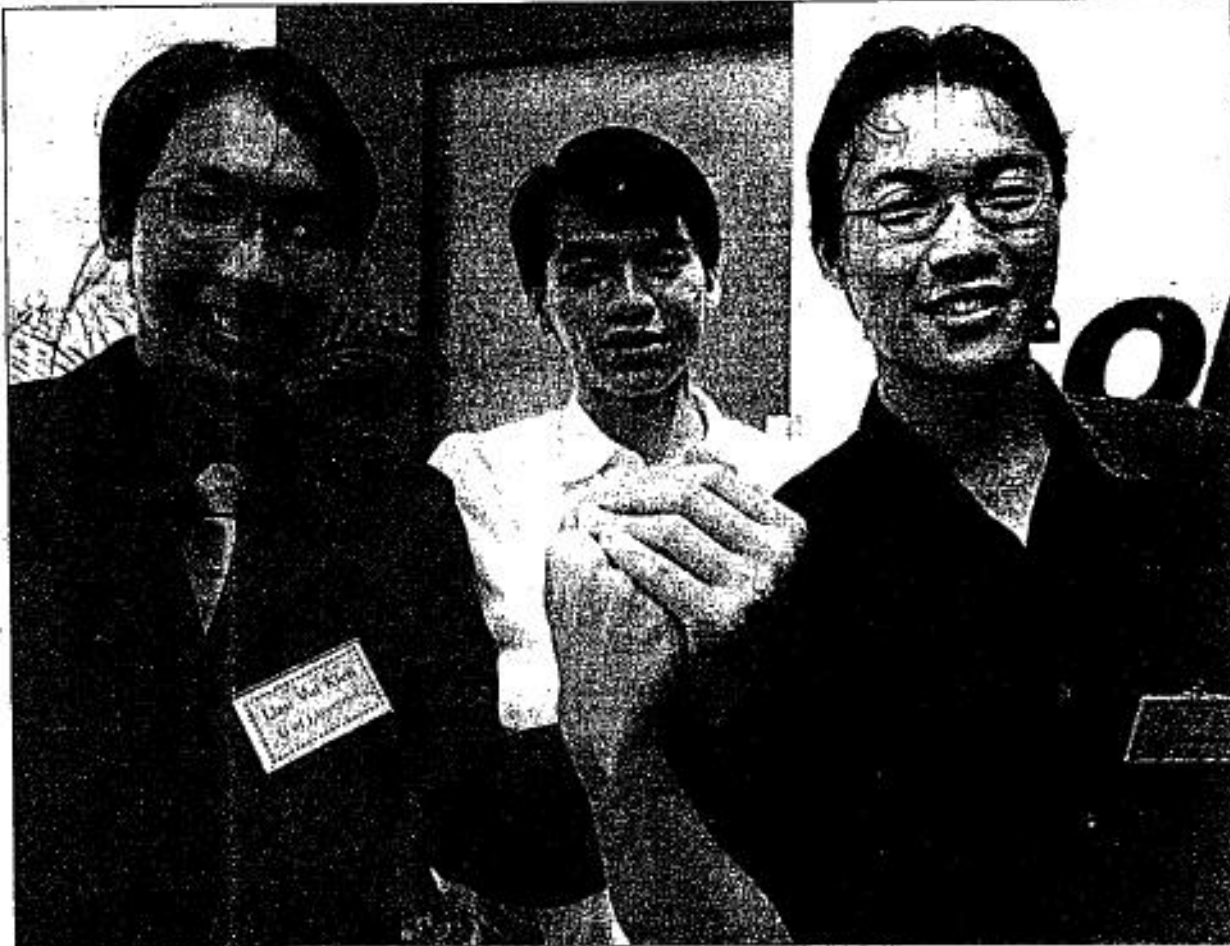
PhD students off to Britain

IN-DEPTH research on airplane design earned Ho Kar Cheong and Jerry Wong Ling Fei scholarships to pursue their PhDs at the University of Liverpool and University of Birmingham respectively.

Family support coupled with hard work and determination paid off for Jerry, 22, when he was awarded the Bae Systems Matra Dynamics Prize, IMech Best Projects Certificate, Fairbairn Engineering Prize, LMS Prize and IMech Frederic Barnes Waldron Prize in addition to his scholarship for his research on "flutter" (the rapid movement of airplane wings).

"For many years professors at my university wanted to do research on flutter but students never took it up as it was a difficult phenomenon to study," explains the mechanical engineer who will be continuing with his research on the topic in his PhD.

He is among the over 40 ex-Inti College students who graduated with First Class Honours from the University of Leeds, University of Liverpool, University of Manchester, University of Nottingham and University of Birmingham in the UK recently.
