

Inti, State University of New York Sign MoA

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THREE months ago, a Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) was forged between Inti College and the State University of New York to conduct a Staff and Student Exchange and Development Programme.

The programme is the first of its kind to be offered by an Inti affiliate from the US, where Inti's staff will be able to exchange their experiences and expertise with the State University of New York.

The exposure of teaching at a foreign university will be beneficial for Inti's lecturers who will gain insights into effective teaching and research methodologies.

As for its students, the international exposure will be attrac-

tive as it would provide them with the opportunity to live and study overseas. This will help them enhance awareness of foreign people and the diversity of cultural values.

In another development, Inti College signed an MoA with the University of Bradford to offer engineering degree programmes based on a 2+1 arrangement.

The documents were signed by Inti president Tan Yew Sing and University of Bradford School of Engineering Recruitment and External director Haydn Bartlett.

Through the programme, Inti's engineering students are to complete two years of study locally and finish their final year at the University of Bradford.

Inti College and the University of Bradford are no strangers to each other. Both have a five-year affiliation to offer a 1+2 engineering programmes.
