

# Another feather in the cap

INTI College has two new feathers in its '3+0' degree programmes cap – the Bachelor of Accountancy and the Bachelor of Computer Science – with its recent signing ceremony conducted with the University of Wollongong in Australia.

Prof Joan Cooper, head of the School of Information Technology and Computer Science, was there as a representative of the university while the president of Inti College, Tan Yew Sing, represented the college.

The signing ceremony began with a speech by Tan who said he was honoured the University of Wollongong (UOW) and Inti College were able to work together to provide a high quality of education to the young people of Malaysia.

In her speech, Prof Cooper said UOW is an outward-looking university that had established teaching partnerships throughout the world in conjunction with local universities and educational institutes. She explained that the end result of their research and teaching

activities was a world-class university catering to the needs of students.

Prof Cooper also said the university had positioned itself as an innovative university capable of taking education and learning into the new millennium.

Under the terms of the arrangement with UOW, the status of students at Inti College will be academically equivalent to that of students at the university itself.

UOW was recently awarded Australia's University of the Year (1999-2000) by the *Good Universities Guide*, the most prestigious position in Australian Higher Education. The university has been further acknowledged for its outstanding research and development partnerships.

In addition, the university is one of the largest sites of information technology and telecommunications research and has been declared by the New South Wales government to be the Centre of Expertise for IT and Telecommunications in the state.
