Offered under its Business, Engineering and Computer & IT programmes. The programmes are popular among students as they are offered in collaboration with some of the most prestigious universities in Australia.

Students can opt to complete their degree studies entirely at Inti or do the initial 18 months to two years at Inti before continuing their studies in Australia.

Under the '3+0' arrangement with the University of Wollongong students can earn a Bachelor of Computer Science or a Bachelor of Accountancy degree entirely at Inti Subang Jaya or Inti Sarawak. The agreement with the university ensures that the status of students at Inti College is equivalent academically to that of the students in Australia.

students who are interested in pursuing a Commerce degree in Australia. Inti students can now opt to pursue a '2+1' degree in Commerce majoring in Corporate Finance, Management, Marketing and International Business. In the case of an Accounting major, a '1+2' option is possible.

This will appeal to students as they will be studying at one of Australia's oldest and most prestigious universities that offers a high standard of living, coupled with a low cost in living expenses when compared with other parts of Australia.

The University of Adelaide is internationally-recognised for its specialised fields including key areas of scientific, technological and agricultural research.

The university offers a total of 12 scholarships to Inti College students transferring

Engineering studies.

Other than the University of Adelaide, students can obtain an Australian business degree from Queensland University of Technology (QUT) and University of Wollongong (UOW) by doing three semesters at Inti College before proceeding to the respective universities.

Alternatively, students can choose to do four semesters at Inti and the final two semesters at Swinburne University of Technology.

The Computing and Information Technology Programme at Inti is designed to meet the critical demand for highly-skilled manpower. The programme focuses on developing a student's design, analytical and managerial skills.

Students enrolled in the programme will study at Inti for four semesters before proceeding to the partner universities such as the University of Sydney, QUT, University of Melbourne, Swinburne University of

Wollongong.

Those who aspire to obtain an engineering degree from the prestigious University of Adelaide can opt to do a '2+3' degree programme majoring in Mechatronics, Civil Mechanical or Electrical Engineering.

Other than the University of Adelaide, the other universities Inti is affiliated to are University of Tasmania, University of New South Wales, University of Newcastle, Swinburn University of Technology, UOW and QUT.

In order to provide students with fine facilities Inti's engineering labs have been equipped with the most up-to-date technology and some specialised labs have even been fitted with high sophisticated instruments.

Entry requirements are STPM, A-Level or the University Foundation Programme or its equivalent. The next intake is on Aug 25.
