

## Inti and Chinese partner varsity to set up corporate training centre

THE Inti International Group of Colleges and China's Tsinghua University have signed a memorandum of agreement (MoA) to jointly set up a corporate training centre in Malaysia.

Inti college president Tan Yew Sing said this meant both Inti and Tsinghua University could conduct collaborative training programmes in Malaysia as well as at the university's Centre of Overseas Exchanges in China.

Deputy International Trade and Industry Minister Datuk Kerk Choo Ting witnessed the signing at the college in Nilai.

"Corporate training is rated highly as those working seek to enhance

their existing knowledge," said Tan in his speech.

He said Inti's corporate training arm, Inti Management Services Sdn Bhd (IMS), would recruit business executives in Malaysia, Singapore, Thailand, Indonesia and Vietnam for its training programmes.

"IMS and Tsinghua University are presently organising an executive seminar on *Business and Investment in China* to be held at the university from Dec 10 to Dec 15," he said.

Tan said participants would gain an in-depth knowledge of contemporary China from the professors, experts and senior government officials will be making presentations at the seminar.

Such knowledge would help attract investment in China, he adding that participants would be taken on visits to industrial sites.

Tan believed that the seminar provided excellent networking opportunities for businessmen interested in pursuing business ventures in China.

Inti is proud to be associated with the Beijing-based Tsinghua University as it was well-known for its professional training, scientific research and development, Tan said.

Tsinghua University Centre for Overseas Academic and Cultural Exchanges director Prof Cui Guohua said the university had previously organised a training course for officials in the Malaysian government.
