“It was fun and I prepared

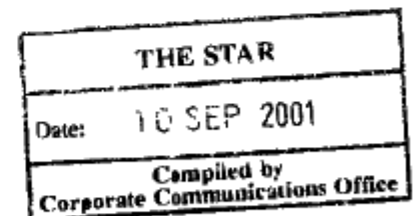
by surfing the Internet a lot, although I had to skip other activities like football these past few weeks,” said Su, who was also one of the 14 top scorers in the quiz.
