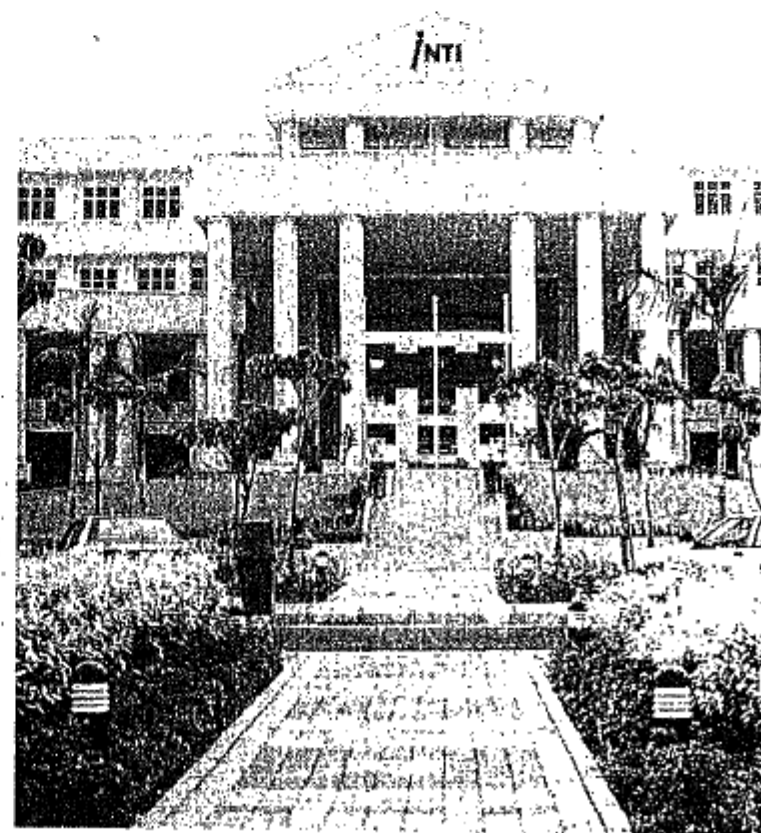
"Inti's plans for the future is contained in our Vision 2010 where we intend to develop our colleges into forward-looking internationalised E-campuses with emphasis into our plans to make Inti an IT-

focused college.

"Already, our main campus in Nilai has been fitted with state-of-the-art facilities including a fibre optic local area network, computer and engineering laboratories with sophisticated application software, a well-stocked and fully computerised library, and extensive recreational facilities. To ensure that our students take advantage of the ever growing body of knowledge available in electronic form, we have installed over 1,600 Internet data points at the student hostel rooms. We are the only private college in the country with this facility.

"Inti has also developed various software programmes including the Electronic Project Resources Information Dissertation Exchange (Inti e-pride), Broadcasting Radio Audio Video Online Services (Inti Bravos) and Communication Hub Access Network Nodes with Extendable Lines (Inti Channel). These facilitate the students' online learning process where, among other things, they can access dissertations and special study R&D projects.

"Besides that, we are also building a resource centre, a four-storey multimedia learning environment spanning 110,000 sq ft of area to enable students to readily get connected to the Internet. The interactive multimedia resources available here will allow students to for both creative and independent"
