

# INTI in synergistic tie-up

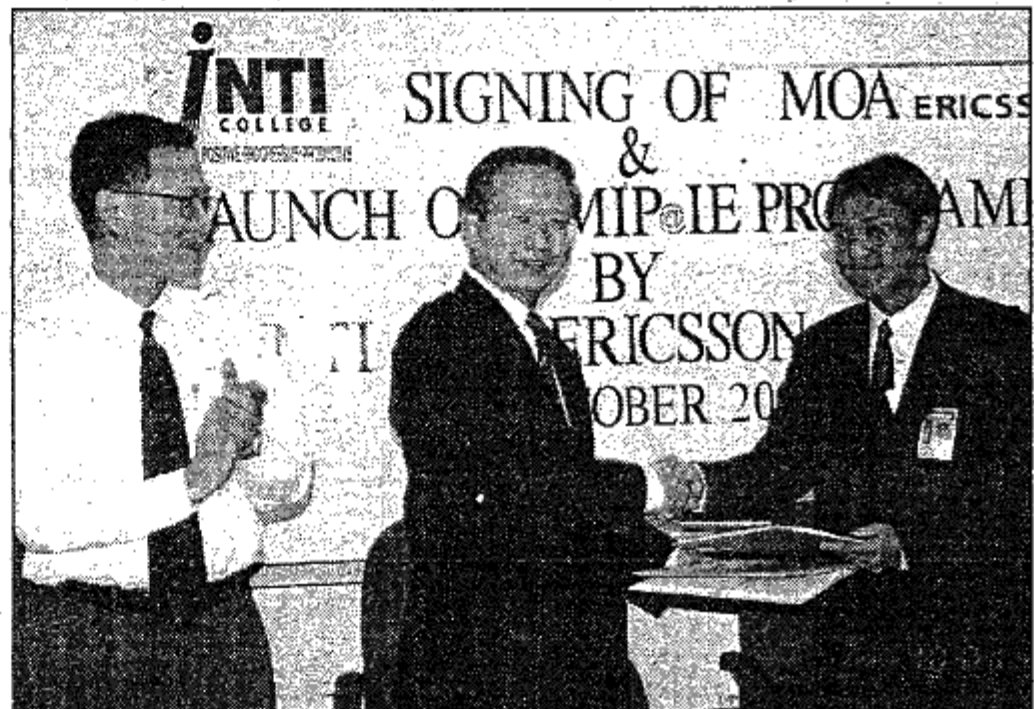
