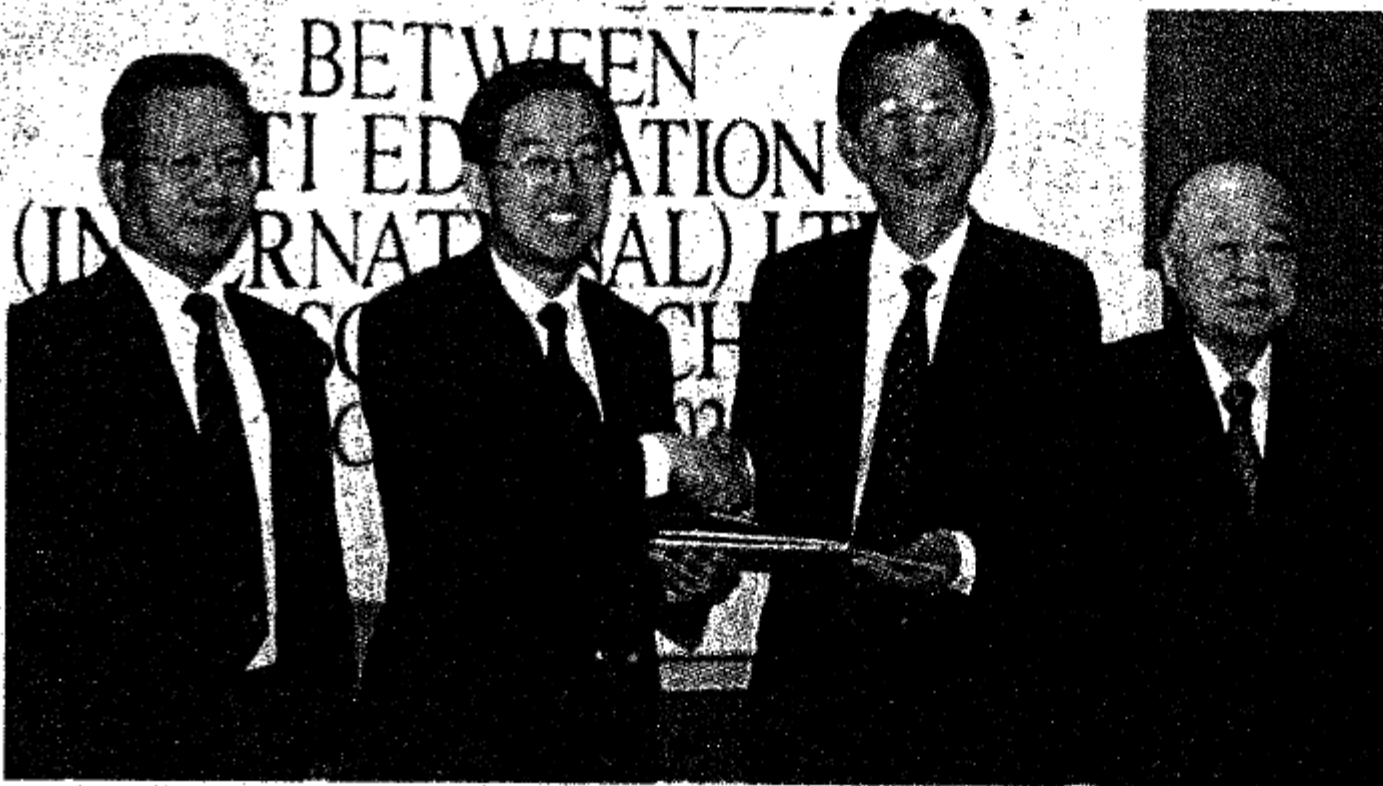


# INTI reinforces presence in China

**I**NTI Education (International) Limited signed an agreement with Wu Jie International School in Kunming, China, to offer INTI's university foundation programme and certificate in Computing and Information Technology in Bandar Baru Nilai recently.

Tan Yew Sing, president of the INTI International Group of Colleges and Tan Sri Ngan Ching Wen, chairman of Group 5 International Investment Limited were the signatories.

The collaborative agreement will allow students who had completed their high school studies or equivalent at Wu Jie to undertake the programme for a year before pursuing their studies at INTI College for a diploma or degree programme.

Tan said the agreement was expected to garner good response from parents in China as it was not only an option that was cost saving but also provide students with a new collegiate environment abroad.

"As part of INTI's franchise strategy to promote its educational programmes overseas, the collaboration with Wu Jie further reinforces our presence in China," he said, adding that they were making similar arrangements in other provinces such as Shenzhen, Shanghai, Guang Zi and Sze Ann.
