Award presentation, fundraising event at Inti

A TOTAL of 472 students from Inti College Malaysia, including 219 students from Inti College Subang Jaya received awards in recognition for their academic achievement last semester at a special award presentation ceremony recently.

They were presented with their awards including those under the categories of President's List, Dean's Honour Roll, Certificate of Excellence and Certificate of Merit.

Certificate of Merit winner Ivana Chen was one of only three recipients of special cash awards from CIMA Malaysia Division for her excellent achievement in her Cost and Management Accounting Paper.
