

# INTI undergrads receive scholarships worth RM6 million

LIVING up to its commitment of providing quality tertiary education, INTI College Malaysia forked out RM6 million for scholarships to more than 400 students.

Of the total 466 student recipients, 19 received the Achievement Scholarship, 102 received the Merit Scholarship, 12 received the Sports Scholarships, seven received the INTI Award for Outstanding Students and another 12 students were awarded scholarships from various organisations collaborating with INTI College such as Nanyang and the NST-MAPCU scholarship programmes.

Another 314 students received their scholarships from INTI College's partner universities in the United States, Britain and Australia.

Of this number, 75 received their US scholarships worth RM1.9 million, while 205 students received their British scholarships worth RM1.7 million. Another 34 students received about RM800,000 worth of scholarships from universities in Australia.

administrative affairs, Dr Koo Wee Kor, said the amount of scholarships awarded to INTI students each year reflected the college's commitment to quality tertiary education.

"Last year, a total of RM7.3 million worth of scholarships were awarded to 623 bright

students," Koo said.

INTI Foundation board of trustees member Professor Datuk Dr Sheikh Omar Abdul Rahman said the scholarships offered by the college would open more opportunities for deserving students to pursue their tertiary education.
