

SMK Seafield wins choral speaking meet

A TEAM of 40 students from Sekolah Menengah Kebangsaan Seafield emerged first in the third inter-school English choral speaking competition held at the Subang Parade shopping mall in Subang Jaya, Selangor recently.

The students' impressive presentation titled *Help Save Our Poor Earth* beat seven other teams to walk away with RM1,000 and a trophy.

In second place was Sekolah Menengah Kebangsaan (P) Taman Petaling team, who took home RM500 and a trophy. The 40-member team grabbed the crowd's atten-

tion with their presentation titled *Our Guardian Angels*.

Sekolah Menengah Kebangsaan SS17 team came in third with a presentation titled *A World Of Its Own*. The 38-member team won RM300 and a trophy.

More than 500 students from eight schools in the Klang Valley participated in the annual contest, which was organised by the mall and sponsored by Event Works Sdn Bhd and McDonald's.
