

# Two students from China killed in crash

**NILAI, Sun.** — Two students from China studying at INTI College here were killed, while two others were injured when the car they were travelling in was involved in an accident in Jalan Nilai-Sepang yesterday.

Wong Lei and Xu Ying Ting, both 19, died on the spot.

They were students in the college's Business Foundation programme.

The others in the car were driver Alex Gan, 19, from Malacca, and Zhang Heng, 18, from China.

Gan sustained bruises and light injuries to the head and is receiving treatment at the Seremban Hospital, while Zhang sustained serious injuries in the abdomen and lower half of the body and has been transferred to the Columbia Asia Medical Centre in Seremban for further treatment.

The four were classmates and were believed to have been heading back from dinner when the incident occurred.

According to the college, Wong and Xu's families had been notified.

The bodies have been sent for post-mortem at the Seremban Hospital.

State traffic chief Assistant Superintendent Abdul Majid Manaf said the incident occurred at 9.30pm.

He said it was believed that the driver lost control of the car, causing it to skid and crash into trees on the road divider.

Due to the impact of the crash, both victims were flung out of the car.
