

Inti College in broadband move

INTI College is taking steps to position itself as a broadband-enabled campus under a collaboration with Internet solutions provider TM Net Sdn Bhd.

The collaboration will support the technical implementation of Inti electronic campus service to all students such as the use of smartcard applications, total campus management system, video streaming, lecture-on-demand video and e-campus online services.

The project which costs over RM1 million will involve the provision of wired and wireless Internet connectivity at 20.1 megabits per second (Mbps) for Inti's campuses and hostels throughout the country.

The main server for Inti's e-campus service is to be located at TM Net's data centre in Brickfields, which has Internet connectivity of up to 155Mbps.

TM Net's chairman Datuk Dr Md Khir Abdul Rahman says given Inti's huge band-

width requirement, the company is not ruling out the possibility of offering bandwidth connectivity exceeding 20.1Mbps in the future.

Inti is TM Net's first site for the implementation of its seamless and integrated enterprise-wide network connectivity solutions for multiple centres, he adds.

Mohd Khir says the company is currently also in talks with not less than five public and private institutions of higher learning for the provisioning of such solutions.
