

HIGHER EDUCATION FAIR from Dec 4 at PWTC

KUALA LUMPUR, Tues. — An education fair offering information on local higher education will be held at the Putra World Trade Centre from Dec 4.

The two-day Facon Education Fair 2004 will have local exhibitors including Tun Abdul Razak University (Unitar), University College of Technology and Management Malaysia (KUTPM), Pusat Teknologi dan Pengurusan Lanjutan (PTPL), the International World View College and Inti College.
