

Inti and Resorts World team up

INTI College Malaysia will collaborate with Resorts World Bhd to run hospitality programmes at Kolej Antarabangsa Genting Inti. An agreement to the effect was signed recently between Inti Universal Holdings Bhd and Resorts World.

Established in 2000, Kolej Antarabangsa Genting (KAG) is operated and managed by Genting Centre of Excellence Sdn Bhd, a subsidiary of Resorts World Bhd.

The joint venture company will be incorporated in the name of Genting Inti Education Sdn Bhd, subject to the approval of the Companies Commission of Malaysia.

The education licence issued to KAG will be transferred to the joint venture company and the name of KAG will be changed to Kolej Antarabangsa Genting Inti.

The joint venture exercise will be undertaken between Genting Irama Sdn Bhd, a wholly owned subsidiary of Resorts World Bhd and by Inti Higher Learning Centre Sdn Bhd, a wholly-owned subsidiary of Inti Universal Holdings Bhd.

The total investment is expected to amount to RM3mil which will be borne equally by both parties.

The agreement was signed by the Executive Director and Executive Vice-President for Public Affairs and Human Resources of Resorts World Bhd, Tan Sri Alwi Jantan, and the Managing Director of Inti Universal Holdings Bhd. and President of Inti Group of Colleges, Tan Yew Sing.

KAG, which is located at Taman Gohtong Jaya, a 15-minute drive from Genting Highlands Resort currently runs a Certificate in Hotel Operations and Diploma in Hotel Operations Management.

KAG has also established agreements with Griffith University (Australia) for students to transfer into the Bachelor of Hotel Management, Oxford Brookes University (UK) for Bachelor of Science in Hotel & Restaurant Management and Southern New Hampshire University (USA) for Bachelor of Applied Science in Hospitality Administration.

The strengths of both Resorts World and Inti as leaders in their respective fields will be complement through the offering of training and education in the tourism, leisure and hospitality industries.

Students of the proposed Kolej Antarabangsa Genting Inti will enjoy the advantage of doing their practical training, as part of their course requirement, with any of Resorts World's establishments.
