The 3+1 Bachelor of Engineering twinning programme is an extension of the previous 2+2 advanced standing arrangement.

INTI College's working relationship with the University of Adelaide has made possible the offering of more options for students.

A twinning programme was launched last June by the two institutions to offer the university's Bachelor of Commerce and Bachelor of Engineering degrees with specialties in Accounting, Corporate Finance, Marketing, Management and International Business; and Computer Systems, Electrical & Electronic, Civil & Structural and Telecommunications.

Present were INTI's president Tan Yew Sing and the University of Adelaide's Pro-Vice Chancellor (International) Professor John Taplin.

The 3+1 Bachelor of Engineering twinning programme is an ex-

ension of the previous 2+2 advanced standing arrangement.

This programme allows students to complete up to the first three years of their engineering curriculum at INTI College Malaysia.

The Bachelor of Commerce programme comes with 1½ + 1½ and 1+2 arrangements.

The new options offered by INTI and Adelaide are an alternative to students who cannot afford the means to pursue tertiary education for the full duration in Australia.

Adelaide staff and alumni include Nobel laureates in medicine, physics and literature; and corporate leaders.

INTI offers three scholarships: Achievement, Merit and Sports Special Talent.
