The INTI-Laureate Merit Scholarship is offered to students with outstanding academic results while those with strong leadership qualities and have been active in serving their schools and community can apply for the INTI Leadership X-celence Scholarship.

INTI also provides aid to students who excel in sports under the INTI Sports X-celence Scholarship.

Tuition fee grants provided

In addition to scholarships, INTI offers Edu-Assist, a partial grant on tuition fees with the aim of minimising out-of-pocket tuition fees that students are required to cover.

Malaysian students from families with a joint monthly household income of RM6,000 and below (in Peninsular Malaysia) and RM5,000 and below (in Sabah and Sarawak) are eligible to apply for INTI Edu-Assist for this year's intakes.

The amount of the financial aid varies by programme and by campus. A monthly payment plan is available for aid recipients, offering greater flexibility in terms of payment.

There are abundant means by which students of INTI can earn internationally recognised foundation, undergraduate and postgraduate qualifications across multiple disciplines.

By providing students the opportunity to leverage on the INTI edge, which encompasses international exposure, innovative learning and individual development, INTI enables them to adapt seamlessly to the working environment and be assets to their employers and society.
