

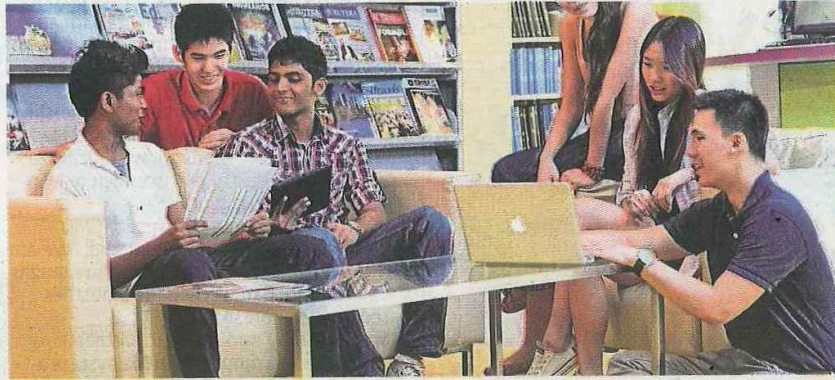
Going global with the right edge
